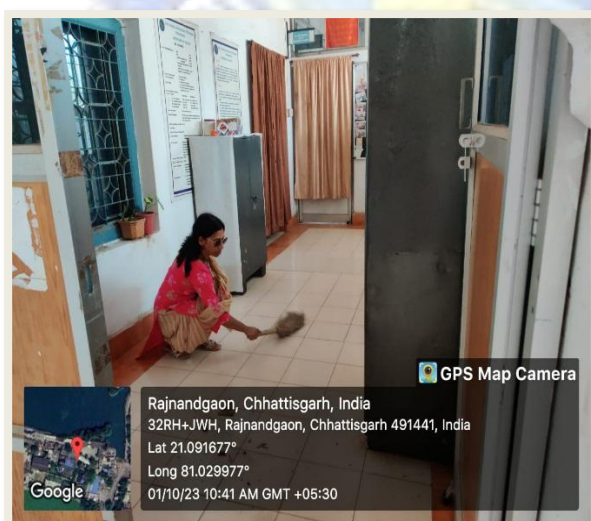
CLEAN INDIA CAMPAIGN

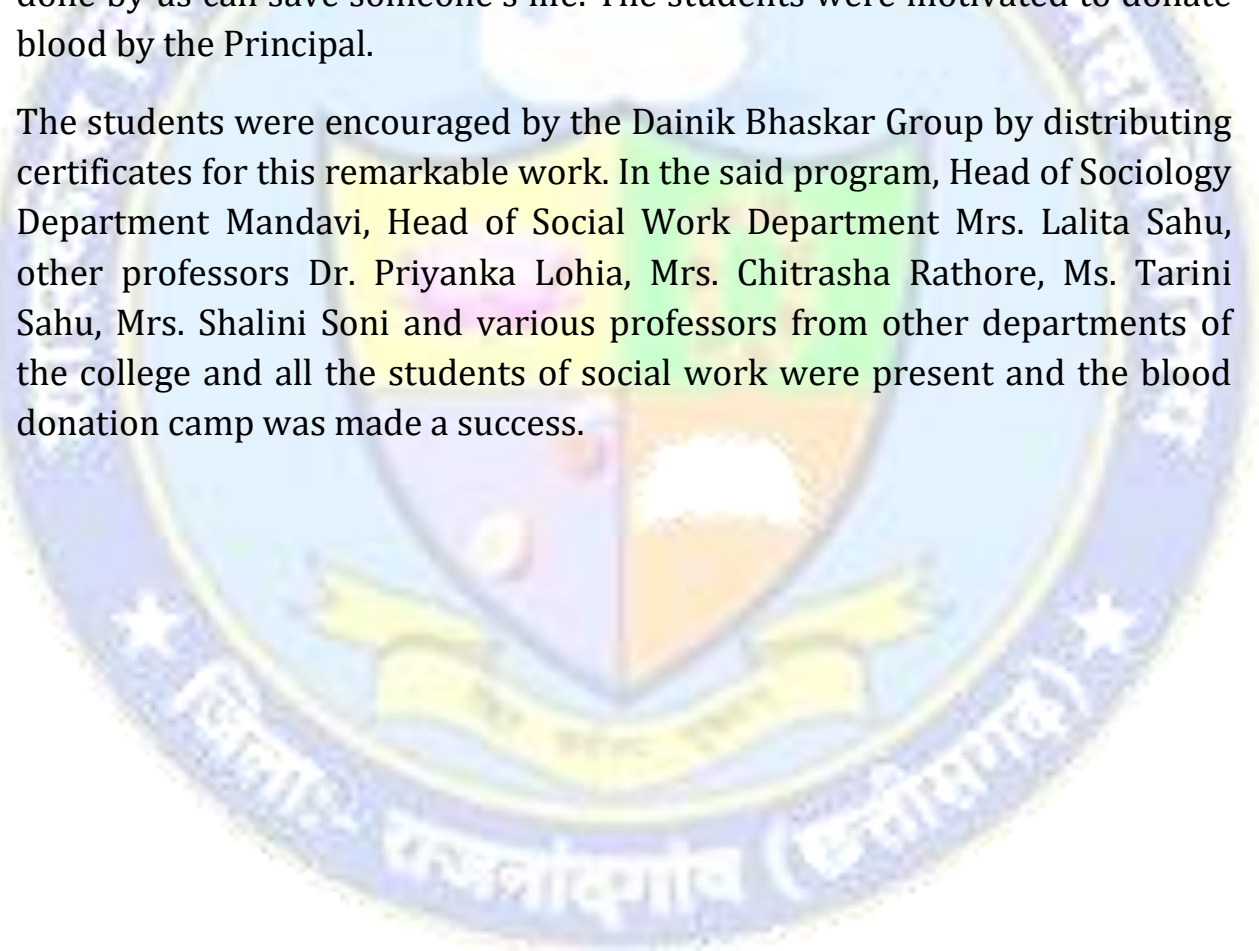

TRAFFIC SAFETY WEEK

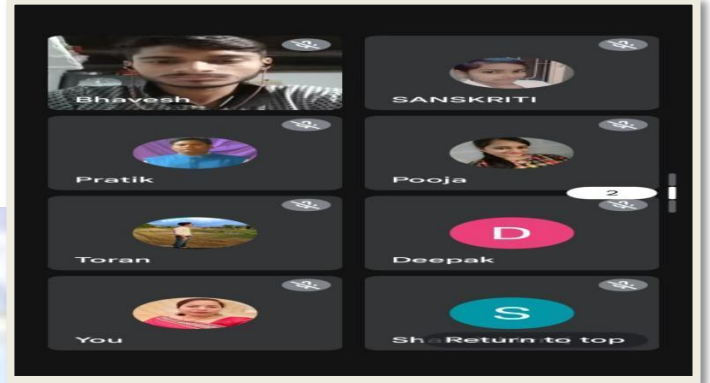
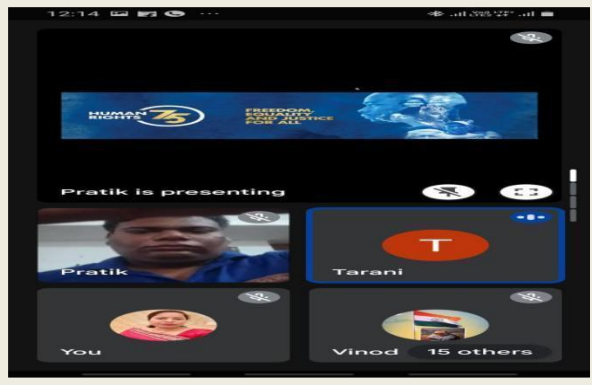
