Today on 24/08/2023, the Department of Sociology of Government Digvijay Autonomous Postgraduate College, Rajnandgaon organized cleanliness awareness in village Bori under the extension activity. The said program was organized under the guidance of Principal Dr. K.L. Tandekar and Sociology Department President Dr. A.K. Mandavi. A public awareness program related to dengue malaria was conducted in which an awareness rally was taken out from Government Higher Secondary School Bori towards village Bori. An awareness rally was taken out from the village school and gram panchayat to the entire village, in which slogans were raised for awareness by the students of social work and sociology, in which a rally was taken out in collaboration with the students of 10th, 11th and 12th of the school. In which the children raised slogans like "This time attack on dengue malaria", "We all have decided to make the city dengue free", "Dengue disease will go away when all of us will participate", using such slogans, the students took out a rally among the villagers in the entire village. An awareness rally was taken out to make the villagers aware. A street play was organised on dengue and malaria in the village market square. In which the students explained how dengue spreads and the ways to avoid dengue through their street play and also told that if a dengue patient does not get timely treatment, he may die. Therefore, keep your surroundings clean, do not let water accumulate in the coolers and there should be no accumulation of water at any place. This will prevent dengue mosquitoes from breeding. The students informed the villagers about the problems caused by dengue and malaria and the diseases caused by them. The students appealed to the villagers to tell the people around them about the problems caused by dengue and malaria and the ways to prevent them. In this way, the students of the social work department took out awareness rallies at various places in village Bori and a street play was presented in the village market square. After that, a street play was organised in the high school of village Bori. The professors and students there were informed about dengue mosquitoes. Digai told the villagers how dangerous the dengue mosquitoes are for us. The villagers were present in large numbers to see the Nukkad. Patel of the village said that the students of Digvijay Mahavidyalaya came to his village and organized such a good awareness program on dengue that he and the villagers who were not aware about dengue were informed about it and the villagers were appealed to keep their surroundings clean.
