Subject: Research project entitled "**Development of biodegradable and biocompatible hair keratin-cellulose acetate based nanofibres scaffold as a potential candidate for tissue engineering**" under the guidance of Dr. Keshaw Ram Aadil, Botany, Govt. Digvijai College, Rajnandgaon, Chhattisgarh, Rajnandgaon, Chhattisgarh-491441.

1. This is in continuation of ANRF's sanction order No. "SUR/2022/003839" dated "10 October, 2023" of **Anusandhan National Research Foundation (ANRF)**.
2. Sanction of the competent authority is hereby accorded to the payment of a sum of **Rs. 500000/-** (Rupees Five Lakh only) under 'Grants-in-aid General' to **Principal, Govt. Digvijai College, Kila Para** Under Grant-in-aid General being the 2nd grant for the financial year 2024-2025 for implementation of the above said project.
3. Sanction of the competent authority is also accorded to the carry forward of unspent balance of **Rs. 1336116/-** (Rupees Thirteen Lakh Thirty Six Thousand One Hundred and Sixteen only) (Recurring Rs. 492416 and Non-Recurring Rs. 843700) to Govt. Digvijai College, Kila Para from FY 2023-2024 to FY 2024-2025 for the same purpose for which it was sanctioned.
4. Sanction of the grant is subject to the conditions as detailed in Terms & Conditions available at the website (www.serb.gov.in).
5. It is certified that provision of GFR 212 relating to Utilization Certificates (UCs) for the funds released under the grant have been satisfied and the UC/s is/are enclosed herewith.
6. The expenditure involved is debitable to **Science & Engineering Research Fund**. This release is being made under **State University Research Excellence (SERB SURE)**. (**PAC SERB SURE**) (**SC**).
7. The Sanction has been issued to Govt. Digvijai College, Kila Para with the approval of the competent authority under delegated powers on **20 November, 2024** and vide Diary No. **ANRF/F/9932/2024-2025** dated **26 November, 2024**.

9. The institute will maintain separate audited accounts for the project. A part or whole of the grant must be kept in an interest earning bank account which is to be reported to ANRF. The budget head-wise interest thus earned will have to be returned to the ANRF by way of a Demand Draft/account-payee cheque drawn in favour of the "Science & Engineering Research Fund", payable at New Delhi and sent to the DDO/US, ANRF along with a copy of UC/SE.
10. As per rule 211 of GFR the accounts of Grantee Institution shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority / audit whenever the institute is called upon to do so.

11. The institute will furnish to the ANRF, Utilization certificate (separate for Recurring & Non-Recurring) and an audited statement of accounts pertaining to the grant immediately after the end of each financial year.
12. After completion of the project unspent balance, if any, should be returned as Demand Draft drawn in favour of "Science and Engineering Research Fund" payable at New Delhi.
13. The organization/institute/university should ensure that the technical support/financial assistance provided to them by the ANRF, a statutory body of the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Government of India should invariably be highlighted/ acknowledged in their media releases as well as in bold letters in the opening paragraphs of their Annual Report.
